

Packing for a National Jamboree

For Saturday, Sunday and Monday Traveling

Arrive at departure location in **“Full Class A Uniform”** which consists of: Scout Class A shirt, Jamboree Troop “Class B” T-shirt, Scout shorts, Troop Neckerchief, Jamboree Slide, Scout Socks, Scout Belt, Jamboree Hat, Shoes (no open toed), wallet, watch and water bottle.

All Medications must be in the original containers in a Ziploc bag with Scout Name and Troop # Please include an index card with exact instructions. These will be carried by the scoutmaster.

Place the following items in the **Jamboree Backpack** that will stay with you in the seating area of the bus until arriving at the Jamboree

2 nd “Class A” uniform	Watch
Underwear	book/notebook/pen or pencil
Toiletries and towel	small flashlight (headlamp)
Bathing suit	camera and film
Big Towel for water park	hanger for uniform
Water shoes	rain poncho
Sleepwear	water bottle
Sunglasses	sunscreen
Some Patches to trade	personal CD player/IPOD (only allowed during travel hours)
Bug Spray	Snack food

NO CELLPHONES

Place the following items in the **Jamboree Duffel bag** which will be secured under the bus until arrival at Fort AP Hill. You will **NOT** be able to get at these items until then.

Underwear	Laundry bag and liquid soap
Jamboree issued cot	Lock for duffel bag
Sleeping pad if desired	large plastic bags
Blankets or sleeping bag	sewing kit
Pillow	first aid kit
Extra batteries	extra film
Extra shoelaces	Scout Handbook
Scout knife	mess kit
Remainder of patches to trade	* Blue cards
Tent Light/ Fan (Optional)	Merit Badge Books (optional)

* Merit Badges earned at the Jamboree are recorded on a multipart sheet. Blue cards are needed only if your home troop does not accept the multi-part sheet. Please check with your advancement chairperson.
